

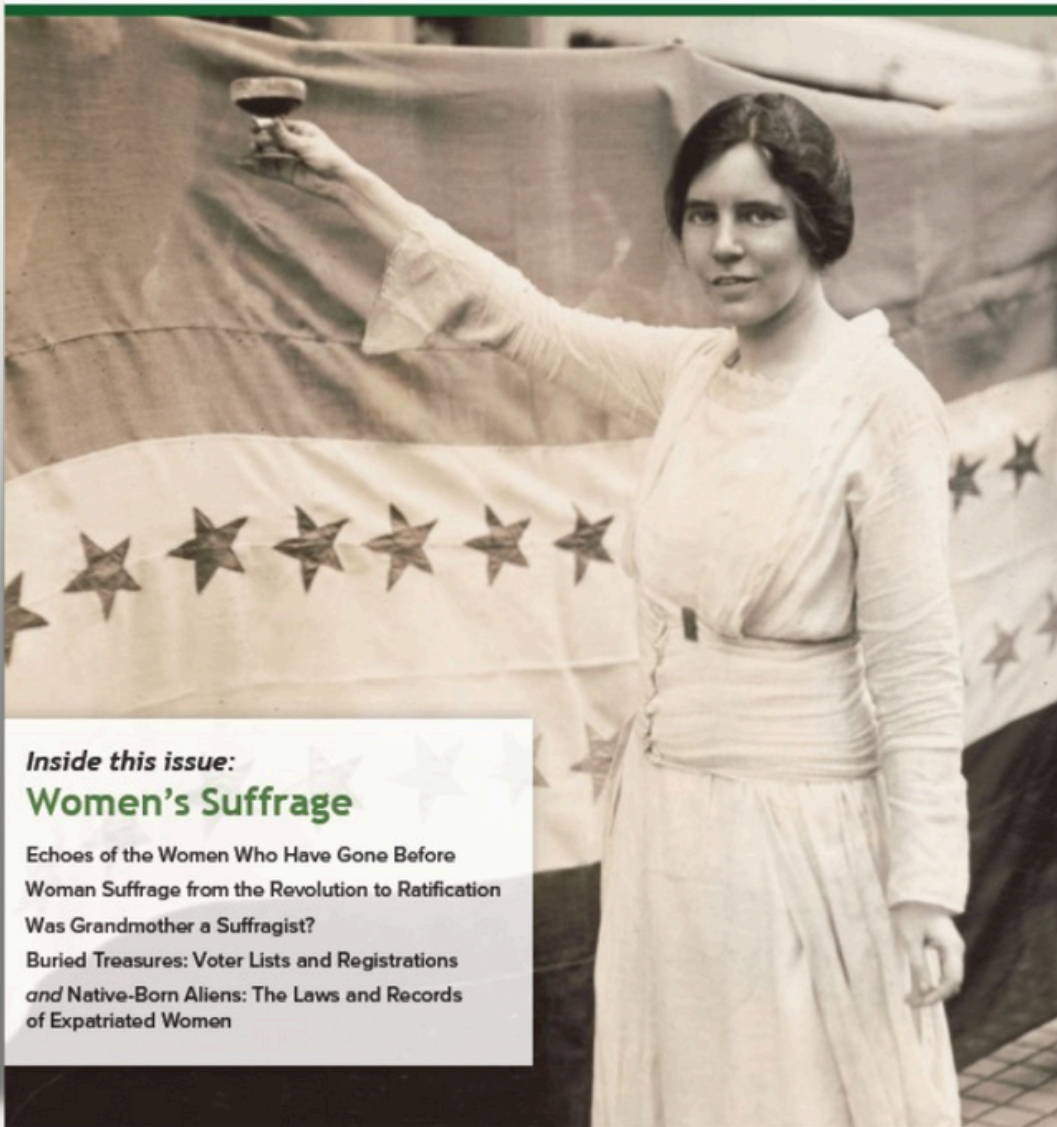

[NGS Magazine](#) began as the [NGS Newsletter](#) in 1975. It became [NGS News Magazine](#) in 2000, and the title was shortened to [NGS Magazine](#) in 2008. Issues before 2005 are not in the archive but are held in many libraries.
